Public Comment:

- Ann Potter requested committee action to ask the City to put in a lighted pedestrian crosswalk between the Gillespie School and La Jolla Elementary School. All were aware of the safety issue and the Chair docketed the item for the next meeting.
- Gail Forbes requested that the Christmas Parade be put on next months agenda. It was done.

Chair's Report:

- A new permit was issued by development services for the pavers at the Kretowitz residence on Princess St.
 The Chair asked the City for examples of other public streets where private residences were given the right to take over the street.
- Chair reports that the unauthorized camping on Ardath Rd. has been terminated.
- The City is waiting for the residences of Via Capri to approve the documents making the neighbors responsible for the maintenance of the landscaping on the Choker and Tee intersection at Hidden Valley and Via Capri.

Old Business:

 Mark Koll of the City reported that the La Jolla Village Drive roadway project was 98% completed. A number of questions were raised about the access from Gillman Drive and the relatively short left turn lane from LJ Village Dr. on to La Jolla Scenic. An audience member asked about the rumored sale/lease of the University land due North of the Allen Soccer field to a private

- builder for office space. Mark did not know of such and event.
- Roseland St. vacation. Because there were changes that had not been previously discussed the committee, with the requester's agreement, tabled the issue until the next meeting.
