MINUTES –May 28th, 2009 4:00 PM La Jolla Recreation Center

ROLL CALL TAKEN. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR APRIL, 2008 MEETING: NOT CALLED FOR A VOTE; NEED TO APPROVE AT NEXT MEETING.

PUBLIC COMMENTS ON TRAFFIC OR TRANSPORTATION ONLY:

COMMENTS WERE HEARD FROM FOUR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ON THE VIA CAPRI/HIDDEN VALLEY ROAD TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES. THE MEASURES APPEAR TO BE SLOWING TRAFFIC CONSIDERABLY, AND THE NEIGHBORS ARE PLEASED. CONCERN WAS VOICED ABOUT THE SURFACE OF THE GUTTER TO THE SOUTH OF THE SOUTH POP-OUT ON VIA CAPRI AT HIDDEN VALLEY ROAD. CHAIR TODD LESSER WILL SPEAK WITH GARY PENCE ABOUT MAKING THE TRANSITION SMOOTHER.

AGENDA ITEMS:

1. **Community Group Appointments to T&T** – Tabled until June’s meeting.
2. **AutoVu Pilot Program**– Presenter Lt. Dan Christman of The San Diego Police Department explained the AutoVu pilot program. Considerable concern was voiced as to its effectiveness and the enforceability of any “minimum-distance ordinance” that would be used in conjunction with this technology. Not a voting item.
3. **Taste of Bird Rock** - Presentation of the closure of La Jolla Blvd on July 16th between 3pm – 10pm: Approved on motion by D. Marrengo; second by M. Coakley. 6 aye; 0 nay; J. LaCava abstained.
4. **Taste at the Cove** - Presentation by David Chao, of Taste at the Cove at Scripps Park on September 3, 2009: Approved on motion by D. Marrengo; second by M. Coakley. 5 aye; 0 nay; J. LaCava and J. Beaver abstained.
5. **French American School** – Presentation by the French American School of their CUP Amendment/modification of street – Presenter Marcela Escobar-Eck: Considerable concern was voiced by board members over the increase in the student body 100% over the currently approved 320 students, and that the school has been operating at almost 200 students beyond the current approved level. In addition, concern was voiced over the fact that the available traffic study for the project had not been provided to the board. Motion by J. Beaver, 2d by M. Coakley to continue the matter to the June meeting and that the traffic study be provided to the board in sufficient time to allow board members to digest same before the matter is voted upon. Approved: 6 aye; 0 nay; J. LaCava abstained. Ms. Escobar-Eck represented that she will provide the traffic study immediately.
